### Condition


Radio reception, Remote Control Transmitter locking range, Customer reports one or more of the following conditions:

- Poor AM radio reception.
- Poor FM radio reception or fluttering sound on FM.
- Decreased remote control transmitter lock/unlock range.
- No Diagnostic Trouble Code (DTC) regarding antenna module are stored in the radio DTC memory.

May be caused by quality issues with the Antenna Selection Control Module -J515- and improper module installation.

### **Service**

Use the following to help identify if Antenna Selection Control Module -J515- (A) is faulty:



Remove rear headliner trim.

A4 - see Repair Manual Group 70 - Roof end, assembly overview.

A8 L - see Repair Manual Group 70 - Roof frame, removing and installing.

Inspect Antenna Selection Control Module
-J515- housing for cracks (arrow).

If housing is cracked:

 Replace Antenna Selection Control Module -J515-.

If Antenna Selection Control Module -J515-housing is Ok:

Identify if the Antenna Selection Control Module -J515- is electrically faulty as follows:

### Radio reception issues:

For reception issues with Symphony II or Concert II radios:

- Select an AM or FM station, that customer states is not satisfactory.
- Switch radio OFF.
- Press and hold button (white arrow) and switch radio ON.
  - The first row will show the frequency (radio station) followed by two digits (black arrow) which shows you a number for the field-strength.

### A8 with MMI


- Select an AM or FM station that customer states has reception issues.
- Gently push Antenna Selection Control Module -J515- (in center) against glass using a non-metallic object (such as a wooden dowel or pen).




DO NOT use your finger, as it acts as an antenna.

If the antenna module is faulty:

 An improvement of the sound quality can be heard and a rise of the field-strength is indicated (Symphony II and Concert II).


# **Technical Bulletin**

### Remote control transmitter range issues:

 Verify, if all remote control transmitters have the same range (if possible).

If the remote control transmitters don't unlock/lock at all:

- Verify that transmitters are synchronized (A4, S4 models only).
- Gently push antenna amplifier (in center) against glass using a non-metallic object (such as a wooden dowel or pen) while another person checks if transmitter range improves.



# Tip:

DO NOT use your finger, as it acts as an antenna.

If transmitter range improves, antenna amplifier is faulty, replace using Part Nos. as follows:

Prior to installing, clean contacts on glass using Isopropyl alcohol solution.



### ① Note:

Use extreme care when unwrapping and installing the new antenna amplifier, as the spring contacts (arrows) can be easily bent (damaged).

DO NOT attempt to bend or clean spring contacts!

When procedure applies to vehicles with- in the New Vehicle Limited Warranty, use the following:
